## "Small steps matter"

Walking in synodality, we actively participated in our Parish activity to share our mission with the Parish youth and let them experience RNDM life during its Mission Sunday program. It was a grace-filled day as we were able to make our charism known and felt. Aside from our RNDM presentations, we also shared with them concretely our being one with Creation. Together with our TP Sisters and youth, we journeyed to Davao's dumpsite exposing them to where our garbage is thrown and the inhumane and unhealthy condition of the residents who are mostly scavenging for treasures in the trash, a sad reality of the effects of our negligence towards mother earth. Then a simple processing was done after the visit that helped each one to reflect deeply on our relationship with the earth and one another.





It was a short visit but with great and meaningful impact for the young who have in turn passionately shared this visit in the Parish and like a spiral effect; the Parish together with our Parish priest were inspired and challenged to come and see the condition in the dumpsite and shared with them their gifts of joy and hope. Indeed, with this short visit, a seed was planted and continues to grow and spread.
